## Alfresco Dining

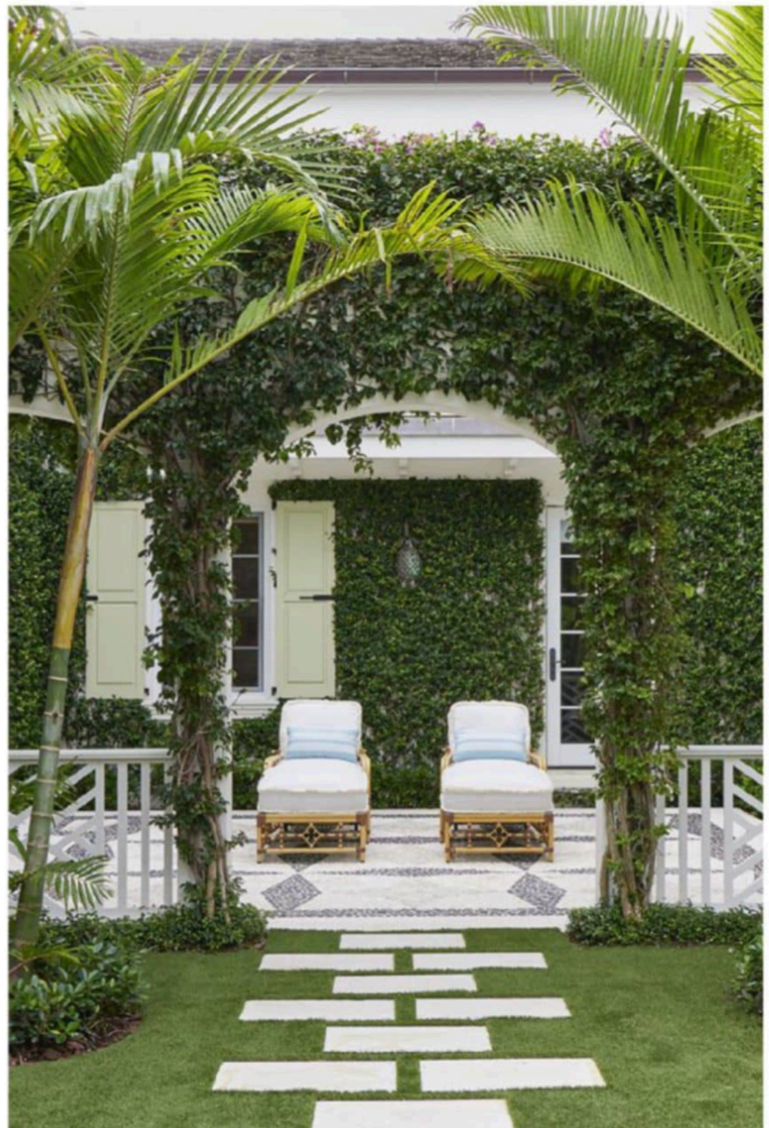
